## 1. Your Privacy Rights

This website is owned and operated by United Immigrants, Inc. and any subsidiaries. For a list of United Immigrants, Inc.'s subsidiaries, divisions, lines of business and websites refer to section 18. United Immigrants, Inc. Businesses. We want you to understand what information we gather about you, how we use it and the safeguards we have in place to protect it. This Privacy Policy applies to information collected through this website and otherwise. By using this website and our services, or through an advertisement or link from a third-party site, you consent to this Policy, including your consent to our use and disclosure of information about you as required under current Federal, State, and/or local law, as well as in the manner described below in this Policy.

## 2. Disputes

We collect personal information such as your name, address, telephone number, mobile number, e-mail address and Social Security Number ("Personally Identifiable Information" or "PII"). We also collect information such as demographic data and data about your online activity on our website that does not identify you ("Non-Personally Identifiable Information" or "Non-PII"). PII and Non-PII are known together as "Information". We may also collect and store Information that you provide to us about other people, including their name, address, telephone number, mobile devices, email address and Social Security Number.

## 3. Information We Collect

### How We Collect Information You Provide.

- a. From You. We collect Information you provide to us: (i) in connection with inquiring about or obtaining our products and services; and (ii) in connection with an application. The Information we collect from you will vary depending on the product or service requested.
- b. Other Sources. None of the information obtained is shared with any matched service provider relating to your inquiry, rather the information may only be accessed by and disclosed to United Immigrants, Inc. employees with a legitimate business need to know in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. Information such as Social Security Number (SSN), date of birth (DOB), address and phone number may be verified. United Immigrants, Inc. takes your privacy seriously and performs these checks using best practices according to industry standards and does not alter or change the information you provide in your inquiry form.

- c. Automatic Collection, Cookies and other Internet Technologies. See Cookies Policy, web beacons and other standard internet technologies to collect information from your computer and about your activities on our website. We automatically collect Non-PII from your browser when you visit our website. This information includes but is not necessarily limited to: your IP address, your browser type and language, access times, the content of any undeleted cookies that your browser previously accepted from us and the referring website address.

## **Cookie Definition**

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record keeping purposes. When you visit our website, we may assign your computer one or more cookies to facilitate access to our website, personalize your online experience and record information about your visit. Through the use of a cookie, we also may automatically collect information about your online activity on our website, such as the web pages you visit, the links or advertisements you click on and other actions you take while on our website. The cookies do not store any PII about you. Most browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies. If you choose to decline cookies, please note that some of the features and services of our website may not function properly. We also use cookies for purposes such as maintaining continuity during an online session; gathering data about the use of our site; monitoring online promotions; and anti-fraud and information security purposes.

## **Advertisers**

We may allow third-parties, advertising companies and ad networks ("Advertisers") to display advertisements on our website. Advertisers may use tracking technologies, such as cookies, to collect information about users who view or interact with their advertisements. ## 5. How We Use Information

### a. In General. We may use Information to:

In response to a subpoena or similar investigative demand, a court order or a request for cooperation from a law enforcement or other government agency; to establish or exercise our legal rights; to defend against legal claims; or as we reasonably believe is required by law. In such cases, we may raise or waive any legal objection or right available to us.

- c. In connection with a substantial corporate transaction, such as the sale of our business, a divestiture, merger, consolidation, asset sale or in the unlikely event of bankruptcy.
